## China has a business-like approach to terrorism

In what can be seen as a small victory for India, the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) has issued a statement condemning the suicide bombing in Pulwama. More crucially, the statement, signed off by all permanent members of the Security Council, including China, names the Pakistan-based terrorist organisation Jaish-e-Mohammad (JeM). As is widely known, China has been the primary obstacle in India's efforts to get JeM chief Masood Azhar sanctioned by the United Nations under Resolution 1267. So, does the UNSC statement mark a veritable shift in China's position?

For starters, China has not yet agreed to Azhar getting listed under Resolution 1267. The UNSC statement is good but carries no punitive implication against Azhar or Pakistan. This is not the first time China has signed off a statement condemning Pakistan-based terrorist groups. The September 2017 BRICS declaration in Xiamen mentioned both JeM and Lashkar-e-Taiba. It needs to be recalled that the Xiamen summit was preceded by the end of the 73-day stand-off between Indian and Chinese forces in Doklam. In fact, India used, according to some experts, a threat to boycott the Xiamen summit. And then in February 2018, China agreed to put Pakistan on the grey list of the Financial Action Task Force (FATF), an inter-governmental body that targets money laundering and terrorist financing. In return, other countries consented to China's vice-presidency of FATF.

The lesson is clear: Beijing will support Pakistan as long as it is not costly to do so. The moment China sees that the cost of supporting Pakistan exceeds short-term benefits, it will stop doing so. Here lies a message for India. To get China on board for designating Azhar in the UN, New Delhi needs to increase the costs for China. India could do this using the support of friendly countries like the US and France. In the long run, India and the global community need to increase the reputational costs of standing with terrorism.

## Artists Rue Loss as Arunachal Violence Hits Maiden Film Festival

Itanagar: The state government's decision to give permanent resident status to two tribes from outside the state has kept Arunachal Pradesh on the boil since last week. After an agitated mob ransacked and burnt the private residence of deputy chief minister Chowna Mein, the first International Film Festival in Itanagar had to bear the brunt of protesters' fury. Several vehicles parked outside the venue were set ablaze by the mob on Friday night. The stage, portable movie theatre, generator sets as well as musical instruments of the artists were also vandalised. The festival was later called off and over 50 artists, filmmakers, musicians from Mumbai, Goa and other North-eastern states were evacuated safely. Bollywood actor-director Satish Kaushik was amongst them. Popular Nagaland-based musician Aloba Naga, whose vehicle along with musical instruments were set on fire by the agitators, recalled the evening and said, "As a musician, our musical instruments are our sole source of livelihood and they don't even have insurance. Therefore, I request the government to also pay compensation to all who lost their valuables in the violence." Assam's heartthrob Zubeen Garg, endorsing Naga, asked the state government to immediately compensate the musicians. On Sunday, the artists' fraternity in Assam took out a rally in Guwahati, condemning the violence.

Chinmoy Banikya, a guitarist from Assam, said, "It looks like a conspiracy to destabilise the region. The issue of 'outsiders' has always played a major role in politics of the region. ## "Welcome To Contest" Posters In UP For Robert Vadra After He Drops Hint

- ✓ Posters invited Robert Vadra to contest polls from his hometown Moradabad
- ✓ Robert Vadra had said he is open to a "larger role in serving the people"
- ✓ He is being probed in a money-laundering case

A day after his loaded Facebook post, Robert Vadra's political ambition was on display in posters in Moradabad, the Uttar Pradesh town that is home to his family. The businessman, who is Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra's husband, takes centre-stage in the posters that have smaller images of his in-laws, Congress president Rahul Gandhi and Sonia Gandhi. "Robert Vadraji, you are welcome to contest from the Moradabad Lok Sabha seat," said the posters credited to the "Moradabad Youth Congress".

Sources say the poster, reportedly forwarded by the 50-year-old businessman to journalists, telegraph his keenness to contest the election, just weeks after his wife Priyanka formally joined the party after a long time in the Congress backrooms. Both when Priyanka's debut was announced and when she went on her first roadshow in Lucknow earlier this month, Robert Vadra posted messages wishing her. Moradabad, currently with the ruling BJP, is a coveted seat for the Congress. Former cricketer Mohammad Azharuddin, who won the seat in 2009, is believed to be keen on contesting from the town famous for its

handicrafts and exports. After being snubbed by the Mayawati-Akhilesh Yadav combo, the Congress is contesting alone in Uttar Pradesh, which, with 80 parliamentary seats, is the holy grail for parties as they seek power at the centre.

On Sunday, Robert Vadra said in his Facebook post: "The years n months that I spent campaigning n working in different parts of the country, but mainly in UP, gave me a feeling to do more for the people n make smaller changes possible by me, in their areas n when they got to know me, the genuine love, affection n respect I earned was humbling ... All these years of experience n learning cannot be just wasted and should be put to better use... once all these accusations n allegations are over, I feel I should dedicate a larger role in serving the people..."

Later, in a statement, he said: "I don't have to be in politics to help the people of the country, but if by joining I can make a larger difference, then why not? But the people will decide".

The BJP sneered in its response online: "Presenting Congress's Prime Ministerial candidate for Lok Sabha elections. #RobertIsReady". The ruling party's Mukhtar

Abbas Naqvi, a union minister, said cuttingly: "In this P-R (Priyanka-Rahul) power circus, a joker is missing. Now the Joker seems set to make an entry." Robert Vadra, a controversial figure because of allegations of shadowy land deals in Haryana and Rajasthan when the Congress was in power, had been seen less and less when Priyanka Gandhi campaigned in the family constituencies of Amethi and Raebareilly in the past few elections. He is currently being questioned in a money-laundering case and has been through marathon grilling sessions. Investigators claim that Mr Vadra directly or indirectly owns nine London-based properties worth around 12 million pounds. Three of these are villas; the rest are luxury flats purchased between 2005 and 2010, when the UPA government was in power. In the Facebook post, he said: "More than a decade of different governments being after me, using n highlighting my name to divert real issues of the country. People of the country gradually realised this Modus n knew there was no truth in any of these allegations. People reach out n show respect n wish me luck n a better future."

He said the country is moving towards becoming Open Defecation Free before the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, on October 2 this year. Shri Narendra Modi said

that the cleanliness of the River Ganga has also been the subject of much discussion this year. He added that today, he has witnessed it first-hand. He said that this is also a result of the efforts of Namaami Gange, and the Union Government. He said drains falling into the river are being blocked, and sewage treatment plants being built. He said that a few days ago, he received the Seoul Peace Prize, which included an amount of about Rs. 1.30 crore. He said he has donated that amount towards the Namaami Gange Mission. He said the gifts and mementoes he has received as Prime Minister have also been auctioned, and their proceeds have also gone towards Namaami Gange.

The Prime Minister had a special word of appreciation for the boatmen (Naviks) involved in Kumbh as well. He also noted that for the first time since independence, pilgrims arriving for Kumbh had a chance to visit the Akshay Vat. The Prime Minister thanked everyone present in the gathering for fulfilling his vision of a Kumbh that was a blend of spirituality, faith and modernity. He also appreciated the role being played by the Uttar Pradesh Police in this regard. The Prime Minister said that the arrangements made for Kumbh this year, have included development of vital infrastructure, which will continue to serve the city, even after the Kumbh Mela is over.

## PM launches "PM-KISAN" from Gorakhpur in Uttar Pradesh

NEW DELHI: The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, launched the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) from Gorakhpur today. With the launch today, the first instalment of Rs 2,000 will be directly credited to the bank accounts of selected beneficiary farmers. The Prime Minister congratulated the farmers for the launch of Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi. He also congratulated farmer families engaged in dairy farming, and fisheries, as they now have access to Kisan Credit Cards. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister said that this day is etched in history, because the biggest scheme for farmers since independence, has begun today. The Prime Minister said that the Government is determined to make the

farmers capable and empowered. He said that the Government is working to provide all the necessary means to the farmers, to enable them to double their income by 2022. About 12 crore farmers are expected to benefit from PM-KISAN. The Prime Minister said that through this scheme, Rs. 75,000 crore will be transferred to farmers' accounts every year. He urged State Governments to send the lists of beneficiary farmers to the Union Government at the earliest, so that farmers can receive the benefit of this scheme in time. The Prime Minister said that while the loan waivers announced periodically by earlier Governments, did not provide long term or comprehensive relief to the farmers, PM-KISAN will not only provide them relief, but

will also mark a massive investment in the rural economy. The Prime Minister said that PM-KISAN depends on direct transfer, and therefore the entire amount will reach the beneficiary. He said that the Government is also investing about one lakh crore rupees to complete long pending irrigation projects, which will be of great and lasting help to farmers in many parts of the country. He also mentioned the 17 crore soil health cards, neem coating of urea, MSP for 22 crops at 50 percent above the cost price, PM Fasal Bima Yojana, and the e-NAM platform. The Prime Minister said that farmers can now avail credit upto Rs. 1.60 lakh, through Kisan Credit Cards. He also touched upon other welfare schemes for the benefit of farmers.

## Where was Modi during attack?



NEW DELHI: The politics of war and polemic seen in recent days between the BJP and its opponents, particularly the Congress Party, in the aftermath of the Pulwama terrorist strike on a CRPF convoy, would appear to have been transcended by a real question of substance - access to the PM in a time of crisis. This is a matter being raised by the Congress on the strength of Doordarshan footage, and needs to be satisfactorily replied to on an official basis from the government and not by the ruling party in order for the answer to have gravitas and to carry conviction.

The reporting of the Prime Minister's activity, which the BJP as a party has not challenged, is that Narendra Modi addressed a public meeting via a phone in Uttarakhand from the Jim Corbett National Park near Nainital where he had gone for a video shoot. The PM's address, as per the Doordarshan monitor, shows the time of 5.10 pm on February 14, but surprisingly his speech contains nothing that might convey that he knew of the Pulwama attack which had occurred two hours earlier, at around 3.10 pm. The proposition that suggests itself is that Mr Modi was not made aware of the terrorist outrage by his office in New Delhi. An alternative reading is that it may have tried but could not get through to him in the sub-Himalayan forest area of the Corbett Park. Neither inference can be acceptable for a nuclear-power country like India, and is extremely worrying. The issue is serious if in the event of a nuclear emergency the leader of the government cannot be reached. The government will do well to clarify.
